Custom Crush: When a producer delivers winegrapes to a vintner for "custom crushing", but retains title to the winegrapes and resulting winegrape product, the vintner must report the custom crush activity to the Commission but shall not be required to remit an assessment to the Commission if the producer has not been paid for the winegrapes or resulting winegrape product. The producer shall pay the assessment for the custom crushed grapes based on the gross dollar value of the sale of the winegrape product resulting from the custom crush at the time it is sold (the assessment may be deducted and remitted by the purchaser).
