2010 HARVEST GROWER REPORT
EXEMPTION

As per Sections 74956 and 74957 of the California Food and Agriculture Code governing *Commissions and Marketing Orders*, an accurate reporting of all winegrapes sold from within Lake County are required to be reported annually, by anyone who sold winegrapes grown in Lake County and that a 1% assessment will be due within 30 days of growers receipt of payment.

Lake County winegrape growers who are exempt from assessment collection fall into three categories:

1. Lake County growers who have fruit unsold for the 2010 harvest.
2. Lake County growers who harvested less than 25 tons in the 2010 harvest year.
3. Lake Country growers who grow grapes only for the production of their own wine.
 Winery and vineyard must have the same tax ID number to qualify for this exemption.
