2012 HARVEST GROWER REPORT
REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION

The California Food and Agricultural Code requires that Lake County Winegrape growers pay an annual assessment on winegrapes grown and marketed. The assessment is collected and remitted by the buyer of the winegrapes. There are however, some exceptions to the assessment obligation. If you believe you are exempt from assessments, please complete and submit this form to the Commission at the address shown above.

Lake County winegrape growers who are exempt from assessment collection fall into three categories:

1. Lake County growers who have fruit unsold for the 2012 harvest.
2. Lake County growers who harvested less than 25 tons in the 2012 harvest year.
3. Lake County growers who grow grapes only for the production of their own wine.
 Winery and vineyard must have the same tax ID number to qualify for this third exemption.
