** "Vintner" means a winegrower, as defined in Section 23013 of the Business and Professions Code, who holds a winegrower's license issued by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control pursuant to Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 23300) of Division 9 of the Business and Professions Code, and who is engaged in producing must, grape juice, grape concentrate, wine, or products thereof, including high proof and brandy by processing winegrapes or field crushed must. "Winegrower" means any person who has facilities and equipment for the conversion of grapes, berries, or other fruit into wine and is engaged in the production of wine.*

PLEASE NOTE: Assessments not timely paid to the Commission are subject to a penalty of 10% with interest at the rate of 1.5% per month. Section 74956 also specifies that "vintners responsible for deducting the assessment may deduct and retain an amount not in excess of that reasonably necessary to cover the actual costs of services provided by the vintner." The Lake County Winegrape Commission members have specified that vintners may withhold up to 1% of the assessment amount to cover the costs of their services.
